

- 4) The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

Of those students, Stockton University estimates that at least 85% of the students are therefore eligible to receive these grants, assuming they incurred expenses related to the disruption in campus operations due to the coronavirus.
