

Low voter turnout expected for Special Election

ATLANTIC CITY - With the regularly scheduled Election Day still a few weeks away, experts say voter turnout for Wednesday's Special Senate Election could disrupt normal voting patterns.

"Voting in October is strange, voting on a Wednesday is strange, its really not encouraging people to vote because your asking them to go out and vote twice and they're busy, they're working, they're worried about their jobs and its hard for them to keep track of this as much as they try," said Daniel J. Douglas, Director of the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at Stockton College.
