South Jersey residents, politicians divided on 'Bridgegate'

"Bridgegate" and Gov. Chris Chtie's two-hour pressonference addressingleaged reprisals by his staff dominated both media coverage and threversations of ording people Thursday.

Tyrone Harmon, of Pleastwille, just seemed frustrated withe apparent pettiness of it all.
