



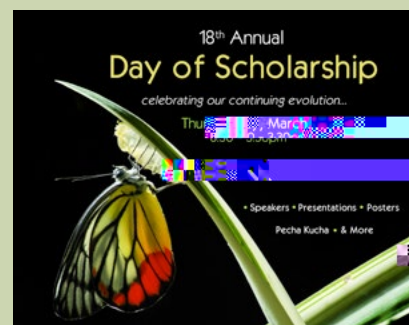
18th Annual Day of Scholarship

The Office of Research and Sponsored Programs would like to introduce our new Student Workers

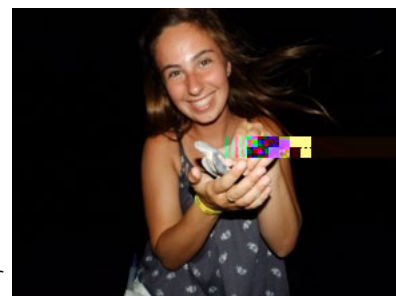
